Reference Service

- Library provides reference services to the users. Students can request required articles, books or any other reference materials related to their studies to the library.

General Rules

- 4) Reference books will not be issued; it can be referred in the library.

- 6) If books issued to a member is found mutilated at the time of return he/she shall have to replace a new copy of the same or pay the double price.
- 7) Readers are advised not to make any marks in the books by pencil, pen & should not tear off the pages.
- 8) Readers are requested to keep the chairs in proper places before leaving the reading hall.
